March 26 - Thursday

- ◆ Arrival at Schiphol International airport in the morning
- ◆ Transfer to the NH Collection Barbizon Palace (it is likely that the rooms will not be ready)
- ◆ Pass for Hop On Hop Off Bus to do on your own. This narrated tour of the city will give a good orientation to the city and a great map for getting around town. You can do this anytime on Thursday.



March 27 - Friday

- ◆ Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel.
- ◆ Leave the hotel at 9:00 a.m. for a full day tour to Delft, The Hague and Madurodam.
- ◆ Entrance to The Royal Delft with the opportunity to see the craftsmanship of a tile, handmade since 1653. Royal Delft is the only remaining, original Delftware manufacturer from the 17th century.



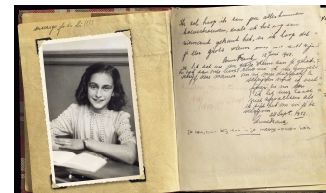
◆ The Hague is a city on the North Sea coast of the western Netherlands. Its Gothic-style Binnenhof (or Inner Court) complex is the seat of the Dutch parliament, and 16th-century Noordeinde Palace is the king's workplace. The city is also home to the U.N.'s International Court of Justice, headquartered in the Peace Palace, and the International Criminal Court.

◆ Madurodam is a miniature park and tourist attraction in the Scheveningen district of The Hague in the Netherlands. It is home to a range of 1:25 scale model replicas of famous Dutch landmarks, historical cities and large developments.

- ◆ Transfer to the River Duchess

BELGIUM/LUXEMBOURG - \$445.00

April 6 - Monday

- ◆ Half-day tour of Brussels to include view of the Grand Place, the Manneken Pis and overview of the city.
- ◆ Check-in at Warwick Hotel.
- ◆ Afternoon is free to explore the city.

April 7 - Tuesday

- ◆ Hot buffet breakfast at the hotel.
- ◆ Leave the hotel at 8:00 a.m. for a full-day tour to Luxembourg.



- ◆ Guided city tour of Luxembourg with lunch on our own.
- ◆ Entrance to the American Cemetery, visit to General Patton’s Grave.
- ◆ Entrance to Bock Casemates: Belonging to the UNESCO World Heritage, the first underground tunnels were built in 1644, in the era of the Spanish domination. The 23-kilometre long galleries were enlarged only 40 years later by Vauban, the French military engineer and fortress builder, and in the eighteenth century by the Austrians. The subterranean defensive passages were placed on different levels and reached down as far as 40 meters. It is these impressive defense works that conferred Luxembourg the name of “Gibraltar of the North”.



After the dismantling of the fortress in 1867, 17 kilometres of the casemates were spared, left in good condition. Since 1933 the Bock and Pétrusse casemates have been open to the public. The fortress ramparts and the historically impressive Old Town enjoy international reputation.

- ◆ Return to the Hotel by about 7:00 p.m. with time for a supper and packing to go home.
